BEFORE A HURRICANE



Listen to local area radio, NOAA radio or TV stations for information.



Be prepared to evacuate and know your routes and destinations.



Check your emergency kit and replenish as needed.



Build A Kit

Have enough food, water and other supplies to support your needs for several days.



Prepare Your Home

Always run generators outdoors to avoid carbon monoxide poisoning.

Fill up your car's gas tank, park in a garage if possible.

Cover windows with hurricane shutters or plywood.

Secure outdoor objects or bring them inside.

Keep all trees and shrubs well-trimmed.



Follow local officials for directions and latest updates.

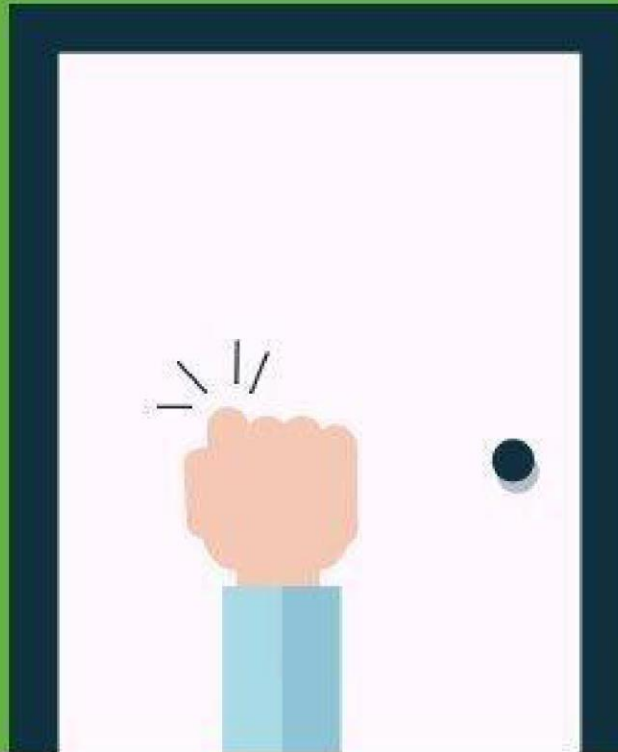
Have An Evacuation Plan
